Homework

Homework is a necessary part of the District's instructional program. Homework is assigned to further a student's educational development and is an application or adaptation of a classroom experience. The Superintendent shall provide guidance to ensure that homework:

1. Is used to reinforce and apply previously covered concepts, principles, and skills;
2. Serves as a communication link between the school and parents/guardians;
3. Encourages independent thought, self-direction, and self-discipline; and
4. Is of appropriate frequency and length, and does not become excessive, according to the teacher's best professional judgment.
