How to help your child **LOVE** reading:

- Let your child see you reading. Talk openly about why you enjoyed the book, newspaper or magazine.
- Encourage imagination and enjoyment by reading with expression.
- Partner read a story with your child. You can read a page and your child can read the next page.
- Encourage your child to read different types of books.
- Help your child choose books with rich illustrations. It is a wonderful way to build interest in the story. Look for books that are Caldecott Medal winners.
