## I.E.P.T.O. POLICY

### **POLICY: Raffle Policy**

---

The Raffle Policy will be in effect whenever there is a raffle drawing taking place within an I.E.P.T.O. function.

The following rules are effective with the Raffle Policy:

- 1) Attendees of the event are not mandated to purchase raffle tickets. Attendees should not be made to feel obligated to purchase raffle tickets at any time.
- 2) Raffle Prizes must be age and gender appropriate.
- 3) Raffle tickets must be sold within a general price range to be determined by the committee. Raffle tickets may be separated by levels and have different pricing.
- 4) No more than twenty five (25) drawings will be offered at any one event. The 25 limit includes all drawings regardless of the price level specified by the committee. The average amount of raffle drawing for a large event is 10-20. Smaller events will have an average of 5-15.
- 5) The 25 drawings can each include more than one item.
- 6) The 25 limit does not include a raffle for split the pot.
- 7) Pricing will be indicated clearly on a sign near the raffle table.
- 8) Members will, to the best of their ability, monitor the gifts at the table. (Keep in mind that things could be stolen or broken.)
- 9) Each raffle gift or package of gifts should be separate and visible to the attendees. A short description of all items included with each package should be listed clearly to avoid confusion.
- 10) Acknowledgement of donations must be displayed or distributed at the event.
