## Music Review Guidelines

1. Review a song
  - a. Review should be 350 – 500 words long.
  - b. Review should be typed.
  - c. Make sure to check your spelling and write in complete sentences.
  - d. Use paragraphs for each new idea.
  - e. Double space your sentences.
  - f. Remember to spell check.
  - g. Include:
    - i. At least three things you like and why
    - ii. At least two things you don't like and why
  - h. Do not review anything over five years old.
  - i. Try to write a review that Peacock students can identify with.
  - j. Do not use the first person "I". Keep the focus on the music, not you.
  - k. Describe the genre (kind of music). If you use a term like "space rock" or "trance," define what it means in your review.
  - l. Would you recommend the song to your classmates?
2. Song analysis
  - a. Include an analysis of your song (verse, refrain, bridge, coda, etc.)
  - b. Write your analysis on the board and defend it necessary.
  - c. Be sure to bring your CD to play for the class.
  - d. Language and subject matter on CD must be appropriate for class.
